tor Jagdeep Singh Kaka Brar from the Ferozepur seat, while the Shiromani Akali Dal (SAD) has given the ticket to Nardev Singh Bobby Mann, a son of former MP Zora Singh Mann.

Ghubaya won the 2009 and 2014 Lok Sabha elections on the Akali Dal ticket. He joined the Congress in 2019.

He had represented the Jalalabad assembly seat in the Vidhan Sabha as well when he was with as well when he was with the Akali Dal. In 2019, the

Akali Dal contested 10 of the 13 Lok Sabha seats in Punjab in alliance with the BJP in 2019. Akali Dal's Sukhbir Badal won with 1,98,850 votes in 2019, defeating Ghubaya from the Ferozepur seat. The security breach in Punjab happened on January 5, 2022, just ahead of the assembly polls in the state, when PM Modi was on his way to Hussainiwala in Ferozepur and his cavalcade had to stop and later take a U-turn after protesters blocked his

SP leader's remarks on Ram temple create huge controversy

The Bharatiya Janata Party said that the Samajwadi Party leader's comments are the most "shocking and insulting" remarks on Ram Mandir by the IN-DIA bloc. Slamming the leader, BJP spokesperson Shehzad Poonawala took to X and wrote: "Shocking & Door to Shocking & Doo most insulting comment on Ram Mandir by INDIA bloc SP Leader Ram Gopal Yadav."

He further accused the Samajwadi Party of attacking the Ram Bhakts, stating that with such comments, it is clear that the INDIA bloc is working towards eradi-

cation of Sanatan dharma.

Turkish Police detain 363 drug suspects Ankara, May 7 (IANS) Turkish Police have launched

a wide-scale operation against drug dealers across the country and detained 363 suspects, Turkey's Interior Minister Ali Yerlikaya said on Tuesday.

In a nationwide crackdown on local crime syndicates, as well as drug manufacturers and dealers, the "Narcocelik-15" operation was carried out across 52 provinces, including Istanbul, Ankara, Izmir, and Antalya, Yerlikaya said on social media platform X, without specifying the time of the operation.

The police seized 217 kg of narcotics and more than 1.1 million narcotic pills, he added as quoted by Xinhua news agency report.

The operations involved 936 police teams, and a total of 2,340 personnel, along with nine aircraft, and 38 narcotics detection dogs, he added.

Our fight against drug traffickers and organised crime syndicates, which poison our people, will continue with the unwavering support and prayers of our nation. They cannot escape from us; we are constantly vigilant," Yerlikaya said.

Turkey has long been known as a transit country for narcotics, but the government has stepped up operations against drug gangs since last year.

20 killed in Israeli attacks on Rafah

in Gaza

Gaza, May 7 (IANS)At least 20 people have been killed in Israel's continuous attacks on the city of Rafah in the southern Gaza Strip since Tuesday, the media reported.

Israel targeted at least four residential buildings in Rafah, injuring dozens of people, according to the official Palestinian news agency Wafa's report.

Thé Al-Qassam Brigades, the armed wing of Hamas, said in a press statement on Tuesday that their militants "attacked Israeli soldiers stationed around the Rafah crossing" as quoted by Xinhua news agency report.

Israel's military said on Tuesday that it had started "a precise counterterrorism operation" in Rafah city in the south of the Gaza Strip and assumed operational control" over the Rafah crossing in

The crossing, which has served as a passage for humanitarian aid from Egypt to war-torn Gaza, was out of service.

Since the beginning of the assault overnight on Monday, Israel said it had taken control of the Gaza side of the Rafah crossing, with the Israeli forces killing at least 20 militants.

Israeli forces attacked the Rafah city from the ground and air, the military said, as residents reported heavy and relentless bombardments.

Sex videos: Court adjourns bail plea of JD(S) MLA Revanna in victim abduction case

Bengaluru, May 7 (IANS) The Special Court for People's Representatives, looking into the sex video victim's abduction case on Tuesday, adjourned the bail plea submitted by former minister and JD(S) MLA HD Revanna, to Wednesday.

HD Revanna was arrested in connection with the kidnapping case registered against him by the son of one of the victims who was seen being sexually abused by his son Prajwal Revanna in the

videos that were leaked. The court questioned the counsel for former Prime Minister, HD Deve Gowda's son, HD Revanna and asked how it could take up the bail plea when the accused has been sent to police custody till

The judge also asked that in case bail is given, how the police custody could continue? The court has directed

the Public Prosecutor representing the Special Investigation Team (SIT) to file objections on whether it can take up the bail petition while the accused is in police custody.

Senior counsel, CV Nagesh representing HD Revanna argued that his client had been dragged unnecessarily into the case and he should be given bail. On the judge raising objections, Counsel Nagesh submitted that bail could be granted while being in police custody and mentioned past judgments by the Supreme Court and provisions in

HD Revanna was arrested on charges of kid-napping a victim in the sex scandal video involving his son JD(S) MP and NDA candidate from Hassan.

Prajwal Revanna is absconding and is said to be in a foreign country.

The Karnataka Government is trying to get a Blue Corner notice issued against him and coordinating with the CBI in this regard. At present, the SIT has issued a Lookout Notice for him.

Why fast bowler talents such as **Mayank Yadav should** not be rushed back to action after an injury

It's not Mayank who needs to get out of his head that he is injured, but the decision makers who need to get into their head that he is.

For the first time, India unearthed a fast bowler in Mayank Yadav who could consistently bowl over 150kph, triggering raves from fast bowling legends around the world such as the Australian great Brett Lee. Inexplicably, Mayank, the 21-year-old Delhi cricketer who plays for Lucknow Super Giants in the IPL, is already facing a threat of repeated injury breakdown. He was sidelined first due to a "side strain", which according to Lee usually takes "3-4 weeks to recover" but was pushed into an IPL game this week and once again broke down in the middle. week and once again broke down in the middle of the game. He has been virtually ruled out for the rest of the tournament. Questions have to be asked about the mismanagement by the franchise, especially as at the toss before the start of the game, the captain KL Rahul would claim that he "pushed the medicos and trainers" to accelerate Mayank's recovery and that it's "important that he (Mayank) gets out of his head that he is injured". A stale whiff of old conserva-

tive thinking evaporated from the episode.

It brings into focus two competing factors:
Short-term urges of IPL franchises which desperately seek those two points to move ahead in the competition vs the long-term vision of Indian national team which would usher Mayank gradually into the big league and get him ready for the allimportant Test tour of Australia in December. It's not as simple as asserting that it was the franchise which groomed, selected, and unleashed him in the big league. Does that give it a license to push Mayank hastily through a vulnerable injury recovery stage?

Injuries can happen anytime, but mismanaging or wrongly diagnosing the recovery period can break down a talent irrevocably. Better scientific counsel and patience is needed to handle fragile talents who are just finding their way in competitions and their way in competitions are the second to the secon tive cricket. Lucknow, May 7 (IANS) A syndrome called Internet Derived Information Obstructing Treatment (IDIOT) is emerging as a major hindrance in the treatment of asthma. Experts at respiratory critical care unit of King George's Medical University (KGMU), said that patients, especially the educated ones, were often misled by information gathered online, especially about steroids which could hinder them from getting the right treatment. Prof Rajendra Prasad, former head of respiratory medicine at KGMU, said that every week two to three patients,

knowledge, resist steroid prescriptions for asthma.

He stressed that steroids, when prescribed and monitored by doctors, are the most effective asthma treatment.Head of the respiratory critical care department of KGMU Prof Ved Prakash highlighted that around 1.9 lakh people die due to asthma complications in India annually, a concerning statistic, given that asthma can be managed well with proper medical guidance.

He pointed out that poor air quality worsens asthma and emphasised the importance of aware-

ness and accurate diagnosis. Prof Sumit Rungta of the medical gastroenterology and dermatology department added that asthma, being an allergy, cannot be cured but can be managed.

Meanwhile, experts at KGMU said that according to a survey by the Department of Respiratory Medicine, about 60 per cent of 500 asthma patients were found using the inhalers incorrectly.

This improper use impacts the inhaler's delivery to the lungs, compromising asthma management.

Consequently, patients are often prescribed higher medication dosages (two to three times a day) due to perceived ineffectiveness, when once or twice daily usage might suffice with the correct

correct inhalation may necessitate a separate inhaler for 10 per cent of patients". Experts also underscored the importance of thorough mouth cleaning after inhaler use to manage respiratory discordance and provent dental complieases and prevent dental complications. He outlined key steps for effective inhaler usage, including -shaking the inhaler before use: exhaling fully before medication administration; holding the inhaler in the correct position; inhaling deeply while dispensing the medicine; holding the breath for at least five seconds; and shaking the inhaler between puffs (if applicable).--IANS

Constituency Watch: Amid Maratha quota stir, election in Beed is more about caste politics than national issues

Mumbai, May 7 (IANS) BJP nominee Pankaja Munde and NCP(SP) candidate Bajrang Sonawane are locked in a direct fight in Beed constituency from Marathwada region.

Against the backdrop of the agitation demanding Maratha reservation spearheaded by Manoj Jarange-Patil, this time the election has become less about national issues and more

There are a total of 41 candidates in the fray but the contest is mainly between Pankaja and

Bajrang Sonawane. The BJP dropped the sitting MP Pritam Munde and replaced her with her elder sister and former state minister Pankaja who has a following in the Vanjani community and the OBCs in general

This was the BJP's attempt to make up for a possible loss of Maratha votes.
Further, the BJP also counted on the active

association of Pankaja's formerly estranged cousin and NCP minister Dhananjay Munde for increasing the vote share.

This is crucial as Pankaja was defeated by Dhananjay in the 2019 Assembly elections and the rivalry between the two reached the point of no return till the Mahayuti Government came into existence.The BJP hopes to weather all odds and consolidate its strength in Beed banking on 'Modi's guarantee' and the Mahayuti Government's move to provide 10 per cent reserva-tion to the Maratha community and aid the OBCs

Further, Pankaja, who was sulking over being neglected by the party after her defeat in the 2019 Assembly elections, is cashing in on the strength of six Legislators and her sister and

sitting MP Pritam Munde.

However, there are two negative factors against her. First, Pankaja became inactive after her defeat in the Assembly elections and second she was critical of the party leadership till she was rehabilitated through her nomination.

On the other hand, the NCP(SP)



has brought a big gun to the fight by fielding cooperative baron Bajrang Sonawane from the Maratha community.

This is because Jyoti Mete, widow of late pro-Maratha quota leader and the founder of Shiv Sangram, Vinay Mete, decided to extend support to Bajrang Sonawane.
In addition, several pro-Maratha

reservation outfits have been at the forefront to work for Bajrang Sonawane who has posed a serious challenge to Pankaja and is making it a Maratha vs OBC fight.

Interestingly, former minister Jaidutt Kshirsagar, who comes from the Teli community, has come out in the open to support Bajrang Sonawane.

On its part, the NCP(SP) is confident of making further inroads in Beed ahead of the next Assembly elections slated for September-October this year. Beed, which was traditionally a

ongress bastion, later became the BJP's stronghold after former Union Minister Gopinath Munde took the party to the grass roots by reaching out to communities other than Brahmins and Marathas.

In the constituency there are about 7.25 lakh Marathas; of the OBCs 3 lakh are Vanjaris and 2 lakh are Malis, 2.50 lakh belong to the Backward Classes, 1.10 lakh are Banjaras and there are 3.25 lakh

The Muslims are supporting Barang Sonawane mainly to oppose the BJP in the state and at the national level. After the Maratha quota protests, there has been a polarisation of the Maratha votes, resulting in strong resentment against the ruling Mahayuti mainly in Gevrai, Beed and Majalgaon Assembly con-

As a reaction to this, the OBCs have put up a show of unity in the rest of the constituencies. Both Pankaja and Bajrang Sonawane are reaching out to these communities amid the present division. As the campaigning gathered momentum, Pankaa had to face protests from the Maratha community in various parts of the constituency as a section of the community's leaders claim that she appears Maratha communityfriendly till elections but latér takes pride in asserting herself as the leader of the Vanjari

community.
It is not just Pankaja alone but the Mahayuti leaders are also facing the anger of the Maratha community.

On the other hand, Bajrang Sonawane, who joined the NCP(SP) after parting ways with the Ajit Pawar-led NCP, is getting a red carpet treatment rom the Maratha community

from Gevrai and Majalgaon. Interestingly, Bajrang Sonawane received a boost after Eknath Shinde-led Shiv Sena leader, Suresh Navle, left the party and is now actively working for him.

clearance for greenfield airport in Silchar New Delhi, May 7 (IANS) The Supreme Court on Monday overturned an order by the National Green Tribunal (NGT) rejecting a plea against the land clearance at the Doloo tea estate in Assam's Silchar for a proposed greenfield air-

port.
The Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) notification of 2006 was broken by the clearing activities that were underway, according to a bench comprising Chief Justice of India (CJI), D.Y. Chandrachud, and Justices J.B. Pardiwala and Manoj Misra.

Consequently, it reversed the NGT's Eastern Zonal Bench's ruling and ordered that no action be taken that violates the 2006 notifi-

The court also said that by declining to consider the plea, the NGT

had disregarded its obligation.

The apex court said, "We are of the view that the authorities in the present case have acted in violation of the notification by carrying out extensive clearance at the site in the absence of environmental clearance. Assam says the need was to set up a civilian airport. The provision of law has to be complied with and no environmental clearance has been issued till date.

Notably, the Solicitor General of India, Tushar Mehta, declared in an affidavit submitted to the Supreme Court that no work would be done until an environmental clearance was obtained. The NGT ruling dated March 25 that rejected the argument against the removal of around 41 lakh bushes was the subject of an appeal being heard by the court.

According to the petition filed before the NGT, the airport's environmental clearance (EC) had not been approved and the EIA report was still pending.

The CJI recommended maintaining a status quo until the environmental clearance report is obtained. Tushar Mehta contended that

on-site labourers also chopped trees for residential use and underlined the necessity of taking the greenfield project's wind direction into account. The CJI then referred to a report from the secretary of the District Legal Services Authority (DLSA) in Cachar district that the court-appointed officer was unable to travel far because of the dense forest and fauna, and that tea bushes had been uprooted by heavy machinery. The top court recommended against taking any more action until an EIA report was available. Mehta also argued that 'erroneous' claims that houses were being demolished and trees were being felled were misleading the court. However, the petitioners' advocate, Prashant Bhushan, contended that trees were also felled in addition to shrubs. "Social impact assessments also need to be completed. According to the new land purchase statute, the workers are impacted," he claimed.





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

In a statement published on its official website, the Ha-mas said it has informed Qatari and Egyptian mediators of its decision, the BBC reported.

It said its leader, Ismail Haniyeh, conducted a telephone call with Qatar's Prime Minister, Sheikh Mohammed bin Abdulrahman Al Thani, and Egyptian Intelligence Minister Abbas Kamel, and informed them of Hamas's approval of their proposal regarding a ceasefire agreement.

Hamas said that now it was up to Israel to re-

Details of the ceasefire deal, especially its duration and the fate of Israeli captives in Gaza are still to be known.

There were also reports that Israel was not fully on board with the ceasefire deal as hammered out, but no reaction had come from it yet.

Israel's Channel 12 quoted Israeli officials as



saying that their negotiating team has just received Hamas's response from the mediators, and is now carefully evaluating it and will issue comments later this evening.

It also quoted the offi-cials as saying that "this is not the same proposal" for a deal that Israel and Egypt agreed upon 10 days ago, and that served as the basis for the indirect negotiations since then, as "all kinds of clauses" have been inserted.

The developments came soon after US President Joe Biden reiterated 'his clear position on Rafah" during a phone call with Israel's Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, that it will not support an invasion of Rafah without

Brussels, May 7 (IANS/DPA) There are considerable differences within the European Union over the correct way to handle invitations to the ceremony marking the start of Russian President Vladimir Putin's fifth term in office.

As several EU diplomats told news agency dpa in Brussels on Monday, countries such as France, Hungary and Slovakia want to send representatives to Putin's swearing-in ceremony in order to keep channels of dialogue open.

However, Germany and numerous other EU states consider participation to be inappropriate, particularly in view of Russia's war against Ukraine. "Germany will not be attending this event," a spokeswoman for the Foreign Office in Berlin said on Monday. Washington, May 7 (IANS/DPA) The US government has said that it is examining Hamas' agreement to a mediated proposal for a cease-fire in Gaza. "We're currently reviewing that response. And we're discussing it with our partners in the region," National Security Council Communications Director John Kirby said on Monday. Kirby evaded a journalist's question as to what exactly Hamas had agreed to in the proposal. He would not go into that, he said.

"We still believe that reaching an agreement is the absolute best outcome not only for the hostages, but for the Palestinian people. And we're not going to stop working to that outcome, Kirby said.

US soldier arrested in Russia on theft charges: Report
