Journalist shot dead in UP's Jaunpur

Jaunpur (UP), May 13 (IANS) Unidentified bikeborne assailants, on Monday morning, shot dead BJP leader and Sudarshan News correspondent Ashutosh Srivastava in Sabharhad market of Kotwali area of Jaunpur district.

According to reports, Ashutosh Srivastava (45) is also a BJP worker. He had gone out on a bike in the morning for campaigning. Around 9 a.m., an unknown bike rider stopped him and four others came and shot him.

Ashutosh was taken to Shahganj Community Health Centre for treatment where the doctors declared him dead.

Bhopal, May 13 (IANS) At least five persons, including two Army jawans, were killed in an accident in Madhya Pradesh's Rajgarh district on Monday.

PDS case: Bengal Govt submits report to Calcutta HC

Kolkata, May 13 (IANS) The West Bengal Government on Monday submitted a report to the Calcutta High Court, detailing the action taken by the state administration in the Public Distribution System (PDS) case. In the report submitted to the single-judge Bench of

Justice Jay Sengupta, the state government stated that so far 87 complaints have been registered in the matter and a charge sheet has been submitted in 50 cases. Justice Sengupta has directed the Enforcement Directorate (ED) to present its views on the findings of the state government to the court by June 17. The matter will be heard again on June 24.

The ED had recently complained to the Calcutta High Court that despite repeated reminders, the state government or the state police did not reply to its queries on the action taken by the West Bengal Police on the complaints relating to irregularities in ration distri-bution. Following the ED's complaint, the court directed the state government to submit a detailed report on the action taken in the matter.

Finally, on Monday, the state government submitted that report to the court.

On Pakistan, Congress's Mani Shankar Aiyar's illconsidered remarks, PM Modi's unfortunate response

This comes at a time when Islamabad is sending important signals on improving ties with India, and Modi himself stands tall on the world stage. The heat of electoral battle cannot justify disdain towards a neighbour India can't just wish away

A general election offers an opportunity for a serious debate on Pakistan, India's most challenging neighbour, and on the broader orientation of the nation's foreign policy in a moment of profound change in the international system. Given the NDA's decade-long tenure in power, there is a sound basis for such a debate between the two main nation. sis for such a debate between the two main national parties - the ruling BJP and the Opposition Congress. But evidently, it is not to be.

Congress veteran and maverick Mani Shankar Aiyar's ill-considered remarks on "respecting" Pakistán, because it has an atomic arsenal, and Prime Minister Narendra Modi's counter-attack, generate more heat than light.

Aiyar has a view of Pakistan that has never been in sync with Congress policies or the foreign policy establishment that the party directed for most of the decades since Independence. Aiyar's remarks have always complicated Congress campaigns, but in this case he is also inaccurate in describing India's nuclear dilemmas and characterising the Modi government's record on Pakistan.

After it acquired nuclear weapons in the late 1980s, the Pakistan army began to support crossborder terrorism under the shadow of nuclear escalation, and mounted pressure on India to negotiate the Kashmir dispute on its terms. All governments in Delhi, irrespective of political hue, have struggled to find answers. The question here is not about "respecting" Pakistan, but "deterring" Rawalpindi's threat of escalation, and countering its nuclear blackmail

The PM has a good story to tell on Pakistan and he can claim credit for major gains in the policy to-wards the western neighbour. Aiyar's claim that the BJP government has not engaged Pakistan does not operation on the prior day in office in May not stand scrutiny. On his first day in office in May 2014, Modi spent time with the then Prime Minister of Pakistan, Nawaz Sharif, who had come to Delhi along with other South Asian leaders to attend the swearing-in of the BJP government. Unlike Manmohan Singh, who was not allowed by the Congress to visit Pakistan even once during his decade-long stint as India's PM, Modi traveled at short notice to Lahore on Christmas day of 2015 to call on Sharif at his family home. The Pakistan army was quick to quash the hopes generated by Modi's visit. It launched a major terror attack on Pathankot a week later. Modi broke from custom and invited Pakistan's ISI to conduct a joint investigation with Indian agencies but Rawalpindi had little interest.

Joint military exercise 'Shakti-2024' kicks off in Meghalaya as India and France intensify defence ties

New Delhi, May 13 (IANS) The seventh edition of the joint military exercise between the In-dian and the French Armies, 'Shakti-2024' kicked off on Monday at the Eastern Command's Joint Training Node in Meghalaya's Umroi. Held alternately in India and France, this

year's exercise - which will last until May 26 focuses on training for ground control operations in semi-urban and mountainous terrain under United Nations mandate besides including for the

first time Air Force as-sets as well as Navy and Air Force observers. It marks a new level of complexity compared to previous editions as it has fielded twice as many troops as before and began with a brigadelevel command postexercise.

The French contingent comprises 90 personnel from the Legion etrangere (Foreign Legion), an elite corps of the French Army. On January 26, another con-

tingent from the Legion etrangere had taken part in India's Republic Day parade with France as the guest of honour.

Delhi HC dismisses plea seeking action against PM over alleged hate speeches

New Delhi, May 13 (IANS) The Delhi High Court on Monday dismissed a petition that called for immediate action against Prime Minister Narendra Modi and other politicians for allegedly making commu-

nally divisive speeches during the ongoing Lok Sabha elections. The petition accused them of vi-olating the Model Code of Conduct (MCC).

Justice Sachin Datta ruled that the petition was without merit, stat-ing, "This court finds no merit in the petition. The petition is accordingly diamiaaad." dismissed.'

The court cited previous observations that assumptions made by the petitioner were unjustified.

The plea had demanded that the Election Commission of India (ECI) respond with urgency, including the registration of FIRs against those accused of delivering hate speeches. It specifically referred to speeches by the Prime Minister in Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh, X posts by BJP Chief J.P. Nadda, and remarks made by Union Minister Anurag Thakur in Himachal Pradesh on April 27.

Representing the petitioners, Advocate Nizam Pasha argued that the ECI exhibited inconsistency in its actions against different politicians, suggesting it had previously barred leaders from other political parties but not the Prime Minister.

On behalf of the ECI, Advocate Suruchi Suri said that the Commission had issued an advisory to all political parties on March 1, prior to announcing the elections, and was awaiting a response from the concerned party by May 15 before proceeding further.

The ECI is expected to respond to the allegations by May 15.

Storm over Swati Maliwal's assault charge at Delhi CM residence, BJP lashes out at Kejriwal while claiming that many such inci-dents have taken place in the past.

New Delhi, May 13 (IANS) A major political storm has broken out over the alleged assault of Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) MP Swati Mali-wal at Delhi CM Arvind Kejriwal's residence.

Swati Maliwal, AAP RS MP and former Delhi Commission for Women (DCW) Chairperson on Monday claimed that she was assaulted at the Delhi Chief Minister's residence by Arvind Kejriwal's aide Bibhav Kumar.

She is yet to lodge a formal po-lice complaint but this has already triggered verbal onslaught from the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP).

A string of BJP spokespersons slammed the Delhi CM and called it a 'plot to abuse and harass the dissenters' at his residence.

Manjinder Singh Sirsa said: "Ra-jya Sabha MP Swati Maliwal was thrashed by Kejriwal's PA Bibhav. She had to call up the police to re-port the incident." port the incident.

"Why Swati Maliwal was manhandled and beaten at the Chief Minister's residence?" Sirsa asked

He was also summoned by the Enforcement Directorate in Fébruary, for questioning in the Delhi excise policy case.

SC issues notice to ED on ex-Jharkhand CM Hemant Soren's plea

New Delhi, May 13 (IANS) The Supreme Court on Monday is-sued a notice to the Enforcement Directorate (ED) on a plea filed by former Jharkhand Chief Minister Hemant Soren challenging his arrest in connection with a money laundering case linked to an alleged land

scam. Agreeing to examine Soren's latest Special Leave Petition challenging the dismissal of his writ petition by the Jharkhand

High Court, a Bench presided over by Justice Sanjiv Khanna asked the anti-money laundering agency to file its reply in the matter by May 17.

However, the Bench, also comprising Justice Dipankar Datta, refused to pass any directions on the prayer for interim relief.Last week, the top court disposed of a separate plea filed by

cent overall voter turnout was recorded.

Chadoora voting segment has witnessed the highest voter turnout of 9.62 per cent while Char-e-Shareef witnessed 8.30 per cent, Channapora 2.77 per cent, Eidgah 4.70 per cent, Ganderbal 8.83 per cent, Kangan (ST)

7.89 per cent, Khan Sahib 3.23 per cent, Habba Kadal 2.10 per cent, Hazratbal 3.55 per cent, Kh-anyar zero, Lal Chowk 3.23 per cent, Pampore 4.61 per cent, Pul-wama 5.14 per cent, Rajpora 5.87 per cent, Shopian 7.03 per cent, Tral 3.70 per cent and Zadibal 3.25 Tral 3.70 per cent and Zadibal 3.25 per cent.

This is the first election in Kashmir after 1987 when the separatists did not call for a poll boycott.

This is also the first Lok Sabha

election after the abrogation of Article 370 and downgrading of J&K into a union territory.

The eagerness of the people to cast their vote was witnessed everywhere except the Khanyar voting segment in Srinagar city where no vote had been cast till 9 a.m.

ECI has set up 2135 polling sta-tions including 1004 urban and 1131 rural polling stations in the constituency.

Delhi HC orders halt on tree felling in Central Ridge

New Delhi, May 13 (IANS) The Delhi High Court has issued a stern directive against the felling of trees and removal of vegetation in the Central Ridge area of the national Capital, without explicit court permission.

The order, delivered by Justice Mini Pushkar-na, also mandates that the Forest Department and local authorities prevent any dumping of garbage or waste material in this ecologically-sensitive zone.

The court's decision comes amid reports of extensive tree cutting and land clearing, as well as significant garbage dumping within the region, which houses the historical Malcha Mahal from the

Tughlaq era. Photographic evidence presented in court showed not only unauthorised deforestation but also the burning of large areas, leading to the destruction of both trees and undergrowth. This activity has left behind vast tracts of vacant land, significantly impacting the local ecosystem. Expressing grave concern over these developments, Justice Pushkarna remarked on the critical role of the Central Ridge as a green heritage site for Delhi, particularly as the city faces severe pollution challenges. The preservation of this green cover is essential for maintaining environmental balance, she noted.s court orders regarding tree planting in Delhi. Mumbai: BMC to launch second girder for 'Bow-String' bridge on May 15 By Staff Reporter was prefabricated in Hary- al only between 8 ar By Staff Reporter

Ahmedabad, The Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) officials on Monday an-nounced that the second girder of the 'bow-string' bridge, which will link the Coastal Road with the Bandra Worli Sea Link will be launched in the early hours of May 15.

While the first girder was launched on April 26, the officials said that the process of concretising the lavers of the recently launched girder is currently underway.

"The girder that was launched last month is for southbound traffic. This will take another one month to get completed and once it's ready, vehicles will be able to take the coastal road directly from BWSL, which now is operational between Worli and Marine Drive," said an official.Weighing approximately 2,000 metric tons and spanning 136 meters, the arch-shaped girder

ana before being trans-ported to the Nhava Sheva port in Raigad, 65 kilometres away from Worli.

From there, it was assembled and transported to the Worli worksite via barge, arriving on Sunday evening. According to civic officials, the launch will take place only when tidal patterns appear feasible for the operation. "The sec-ond girder will be erected and launched in the same manner as the first girder, which he had launched from the sea and the process of launching will take around 2 hours. This girder will cater towards the northbound side, which is yet to become operational and the finishing work is expected to be completed by the end of next month," the official said.

Once the girder is launched, authorities will concrete it before laying asphalt roads, followed by waterproofing а process.At present the coastal road is operation-

al only between 8 am and 8 pm on weekdays for south-bound traffic. The second (southbound) arm is slated to open after the expiration of the ongoing elections' imposed code of conduct.

lowing up with the Iraqi side and the Jordanian Embassy in Baghdad to obtain the necessary approvals for the extension, Xinhua news agency reported. She noted that oil imports from Iraq under the deal constitute about seven per cent of the kingdom's crude oil needs.

Over 4,000 people evacuated in **Ukraine's Kharkiv region**

Kiev, May 13 (IANS) More than 4,000 people have been evacuated in Ukraine's northeastern Kharkiv region since Russia launched the latest round of missile attacks three days ago, Regional Governor Oleg Synegubov said. Among them, 2,097 people from the Kharkiv

district, 1,377 from the Chuguev district, 29 from the Bogoduhiv district, and 570 others have been evacuated, Synegubov wrote on social media Telegram on Sunday. The Ukrainian authorities have provided temporary accommodation, as well as humanitarian, medical, psychological and legal assistance to the evacuees, the Governor said as quoted by Xinhua news agency report.

Palestinian death toll in Gaza tops 35,000: Health authorities

Gaza, May 13 (IANS) The Palestinian death toll from ongoing Israeli attacks on the Gaza Strip has exceeded 35,000, health authorities in Gaza

said in a press statement. During the past 24 hours, the Israeli army killed 63 Palestinians and wounded 114 others, bringing the total death toll to 35,034 and injuries to 78,755 since the Palestinian-Israeli conflict broke out last October, it said on Sunday as quoted by Xinhua news agency report.

The statement noted that several victims were still under the rubble, and ambulance and civil defence crews could not reach them.



Within two years, a doubling of attacks from Russia has been measured, said managing director Bernhard Rohleder on Monday morning on German public broadcaster ZDF.

There was also a 50 per cent increase in the number of known incidents from China, he said. Of the companies affected, 80 per cent were targeted by attacks, such as data theft, espionage and sabotage, on Monday morning. according to the Bitkom Director.

Man stabbed to death by relatives at UP mosque

Lucknow, May 13 (IANS) An apparel graphic designer, Mohammed Zaid, was fatally stabbed over a property dispute by his uncles and cousins in Bhadeva locality under the Bazarkhala police station on Sunday, the police said.

Zaid was attacked with knives by Mohammed Karim Parvez, Mohamed Zubair, Taham, Mohamed Shahab, Mohamed Harish, Mustafa, all residents of Bhadeva in Bazarkhala, and their three to four aides.

All the accused named are relatives of the deceased. Zaid had gone to Bhadeva to drop his

wife at her parent's house in the locality. He later went to a nearby Masjid to offer namaz. The deceased's brother Faiz Alam of Almas Bagh in the Thakurganj area said the attackers knifed the victim to death. "He was attacked as he stepped out of the mosque. Nobody came forward to rescue Zaid as he fell on the ground with blood gushing out from his head.


